1	4:00 PM - 5:00 PM		<p>Dudhsagar Falls: Dudhsagar Falls (literally <i>Sea of Milk</i>) is a four-tiered waterfall located on the Mandovi River in the Indian state of Goa. Dudhsagar Falls is amongst India's tallest waterfalls with a height of 310 m (1017 feet) and an average width of 30 metres (100 feet).The falls is located in the Bhagwan Mahaveer Sanctuary and Mollem National Park among the Western Ghats.</p>
2	5:00 PM - 6:00 PM		<p>Fort Aguada: Fort Aguada and its lighthouse is a well-preserved seventeenth-century Portuguese fort standing in Goa, on Sinquerim Beach, overlooking the Arabian Sea. The fort was constructed in 1612 to guard against the Dutch and the Marathas. It was a reference point for the vessels coming from Europe at that time.</p>

3	4:00 PM - 5:00 PM		<p>The Basilica of Bom Jesus: The Basilica of Bom Jesus or Borea Jezuchi Bajilika (Portuguese: <i>Basilica do Bom Jesus</i>) is located in Goa, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The basilica holds the mortal remains of St. Francis Xavier. The church is located in Old Goa, which was the capital of Goa in the early days of Portuguese rules.</p>

The beach is the largest in North Goa and visited by thousands of domestic and international tourists alike.
